THIS WEEK ... WEEK 15 ... (APRIL 22-28)

Hi All.

Your **REMIX PROJECTS** should be ready to share. I've set up a discussion board in ANGEL for this.

- **Post your REMIX to the REMIX discussion board (WEEK 15 in ANGEL) between now and 8 am on Wednesday.**
- **POST NO LATER THAN 8 AM ON WEDNESDAY!**

Remember, you can earn up to 100 points for the REMIX itself and ANOTHER 100 points possible for the “presentation.” That’s a lot of points ☺.

SO, WHAT IS DUE WHEN?...

- **REVIEWS (presentations) begin Wednesday, April 24 at 12:00 noon (PDT).**
- **PRESENTATIONS/REVIEWS end Saturday, April 27 at 8:00 AM (PDT)**
- **Send completed review sheets to me by 11:59 pm on Monday, April 29**

Here's the detailed schedule...

1. POST your remix into ANGEL (week 15 folder) (**before 8 am on WEDNESDAY**)
2. VIEW & REVIEW (for your peers) (**beginning NOON WEDNESDAY**)
3. GATHER YOUR REVIEWERS' COMMENTS onto the [REVIEW SHEETS](#) ←linked here (**after 8 am on Saturday**)
4. Send Reviewers' comments to me (**By 11:59 pm on Monday, April 29**)

1. POST YOUR REMIX TO ANGEL

*Post your remix as soon as you can---well **before 8:00 am on Wednesday morning** (your time). If you are having trouble, email me. I can also double check that it's indeed working and ready for your peers. Some file formats will not work, so have me or a friend test your link!!!*

Don't wait till the last minute. These things have a way of being persnickety.

2. VIEW & REVIEW

Return to the discussion board after NOON on Wednesday to “review” (watch and comment upon) on 10 classmate's remixes.

- ***You will review for the 10 classmates above you.***
- As a reviewer, you simply post your reviews as a “reply” to the remix in ANGEL.

These are fairly simple reviews.

Answer 4 questions:

- 1) your name
- 2) what you learned
- 3) what was “great”
- 4) what you wish your peer had done differently

COMPLETE ALL REVIEWS BY 8 AM ON SATURDAY!

3. GATHER YOUR REVIEWER'S COMMENTS

This might not be ideal, but it's the only thing I have thought of so that you can still share your

research with your peers and report back to me. This is so vitally important to me: *The sharing*. This is your chance to *teach by sharing* your passions, your research.

I anticipate some issues, especially if you didn't post to YouTube. Be patient with yourselves. Be patient with me. Be patient with the technologies. There is time to troubleshoot any issues that crop up between now and noon Wednesday.

The key is to *start now*; try to post or link to your remix in ANGEL, and email me if there are any problems.

*****Remember to test your link or file to make sure it's working!*****
