TASK 3: **Begin P2: "What Does Wallace Want"** – another read and respond paper.

## **FILE NAMING CONVENTIONS FOR 201**

This is IMPORTANT! I teach 5 courses at 2 different institutions. You MUST name your files in this manner so I can keep track of them.

PLEASE! Name all of your files this semester like so:

**LastnameFirstname\_AssignmentName\_201.doc**

I accept .doc, .docx, .rft, and .pdf only. Naming your files in this manner helps to assure they will be stored in the correct course and credit will be given to the correct student. Imagine 75 files all called assignment1.doc. That just doesn't work for me. Follow these conventions.)

***ALWAYS tell me which course you are in as well. Again, with approximately 85 students, you must always tell me who you are and which course you're enrolled in. Thanks!***
